

FIREWORKS DISPLAYS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ISLAMORADA REQUIRE A PERMIT

Anyone planning to conduct a fireworks display in the Village on Holiday events and/or New Years Eve must apply for a permit at the Islamorada Fire Rescue Office.

Type B and C fireworks that leave the ground or explode require a permit issued by the Village. Those who do wish to display fireworks at home, the “sparkler”, (ground and hand-held sparkling devices), and “novelties and trick noisemakers” classification of fireworks, as approved by the State Fire Marshal’s Office, are the only fireworks which may be legally purchased at stores or roadside stands for use by the general public in the State of Florida.
