Residential Rules and Guidelines

Recycling:

Single Stream Items:

Newspaper with glossy inserts, magazines, phone books, catalogs, paper, and junk mail, can be put into your recycling bin or into a paper bag and placed on top of your bin.

PLEASE DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS FOR RECYCLE.

Corrugated cardboard must be broken down and placed beside your recycling bin.



Aluminum cans, steel & tin cans, plastics numbered 1-5 on bottom of container, clear, brown, and green glass from food and beverages only.

Please clean and rinse all material before placing in your recycle bin.

Service will be provided one (1) day per week when placed within six (6) feet of the pavement.

Existing recycling bins will hold additional recycling material.

Call Veolia Environmental Services if you need a recycling bin.



Bulk Trash:

This is non-vegetative large items of various types which cannot be cut for placement as a bundle, or put in a garbage container.

Veolia Environmental Services will provide pick up on a call in basis and will pick up within five (5) business days.



White Goods:

Include refrigerators, washers, air conditioners, dryers, ranges. And other similar large appliances.

Veolia Environmental Services will pick up within five (5) business days of the request.

Pick up of any items considered construction material (permanently attached) is a chargeable service and you must call Veolia Environmental Services.

Garbage:

Accumulation of animal, fruit, vegetable or organic matter that attends to preparation of food.

Garbage containers should not exceed thirty two (32) gallons and not more than fifty (50) pounds in weight.

These will be picked up two (2) times per week when placed within six (6) feet of the pavement.

Yard Trash (Vegetation):

Regular vegetative matter resulting from normal yard and landscape maintenance. **This must not exceed four (4) feet in length. Vegetation must be containerized or bundled and tied.**

A limit of six (6) containers, bundles or combination thereof, may be placed within 6 feet of the pavement for collection with no single item exceeding fifty (50) pounds.

These items will be picked up once a week when placed within six (6) feet of the pavement.

Yard Trash (Vegetation) Oversized:

Large cuttings of vegetative matter which cannot be cut for containerization or bundling.

These items will be picked up within five (5) business days of request for this service. You must call Veolia Environmental Services to schedule.

THIS SERVICE IS NOT FUNDED BY THE VILLAGE BUT BILLED SEPARATELY TO THE CUSTOMER BY VEOLIA ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES.

Bougainvillea, Lime Tree cuttings and other thorny plants will be picked up at no charge after notification by the resident to Veolia Environmental Services.
