

ORDINANCE NO. 07-22

AN ORDINANCE OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 2-32 OF THE VILLAGE CODE, PROVIDING FOR A TEMPORARY REDUCTION IN THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO VILLAGE COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007-2008; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 5(5) of the Charter of Islamorada, Village of Islands, Florida, provides that the Village Council shall initially be compensated at the rate of \$300 per month; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5(5) of the Charter the Village Council elected to provide for an increase in compensation to Council members to \$1,000 per month by the adoption of Ordinance No. 05-23 as codified in Section 2-32 of the Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council recognizing the budgeting constraints placed upon local governments by the Florida Legislature by the 2007 property tax reform laws desires to reduce their compensation by \$100 per month for Fiscal Year 2007-2008.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Code. Section 2-32 of the Village Code is amended as follows¹.

Section 2-32. Compensation

The Mayor and Village Council members shall be compensated at the rate of ~~\$1,000.00~~
\$900.00 per month.

Section 3. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 4. Inclusion in the Code. It is the intention of the Village Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Islamorada, Village of Islands, Florida Code of Ordinances; that the sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intentions; and that the word "Ordinance" shall be changed to "Section" or other appropriate word.

Section 5. Repeal of Conflicting Provisions. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon second reading, provided further that the reduction in Village Council Compensation shall be effective on October 1, 2007.

The foregoing Ordinance was offered by Councilman Sante, who moved for its adoption on first reading. This motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Hill, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


