### **2017 Islamorada Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program**

First Quarter:  
**March 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>**

Second Quarter:  
**June 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>**

Third Quarter:  
**September 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup>**

Fourth Quarter:  
**December 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup>**

On Household Hazardous Waste Collection days, Islamorada residents may take household hazardous waste products for free disposal to a special drop off location set up at Founders Park (Mile Marker 87 Bayside). The drop-off location will be set up near the south park entrance beyond the Administrative Center parking lot. Drop off hours will be 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. each day of the scheduled collection.

The household hazardous waste collection is an effort to remove hazardous materials from the waste stream and to properly control disposal of the products. Waste disposal is available to residential customers only and proof of Islamorada residency will be required. Residents may take the materials to the drop off location and Advanced Disposal will have personnel on hand to accept and separate the waste to ensure the proper disposal or recycling of the materials collected.

Commercial customers must contact Advanced Disposal to arrange for disposal of hazardous materials; commercial waste may not be dropped off at the residential collection site.

Household waste materials include bottles or cans of flammable liquid fuel and chlorine bottles, liquid poison, flammable solids, aerosol, corrosive materials, liquid or solid oxidizers, pesticides or herbicides, cyanides or sulfides, dry cell alkaline batteries, lead acid batteries, Used non-contaminated oils, anti-freeze, latex paints, pcb liquids, bcb ballasts, non-regulated soaps, polishes and similar materials, contaminated oil solvents, oil based paints and thinners, and tires off the rim that do not exceed a light duty SUV. Computer, electronic and lighting waste is accepted throughout the year and will also be accepted during this event.
