

RESOLUTION NO. 20-09-86

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA,
VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FINAL
RANKINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE RFP 20-06
EVALUATION COMMITTEE FOR HURRICANE IRMA RECOVERY -
CANAL RESTORATION SEDIMENT REMOVAL SERVICES;
AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER AND VILLAGE
ATTORNEY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE
REQUESTED SERVICES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE
DATE**

WHEREAS, Islamorada, Village of Islands (the "Village") has identified a need to engage in sediment removal activities to restore and improve conditions within certain residential canals that were impacted by Hurricane Irma; and

WHEREAS, the Village has completed a canal debris clearing and sediment removal project funded through a USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service ("NRCS") grant being managed by Monroe County (the "County"); and

WHEREAS, sediment removal activities under the NRCS program only addressed a portion of the needed dredging work within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village are looking to dredge within five (5) canals that remain particularly laden with Hurricane Irma deposited sediment which pose hazards to navigation and public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Village is in need of an independent contractor to provide these necessary sediment removal services; and

WHEREAS, expenditures incurred for these sediment removal services are to be submitted to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") for reimbursement with Florida Keys Stewardship Act Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village issued RFP 20-06 for canal sediment removal services; and

WHEREAS, the Village Manager established an Evaluation Committee (the "Committee") to review responsive proposals and make a recommendation to the Village Council for the selection of a contractor for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Committee reviewed ten (10) responsive proposals received using the selection criteria and point system detailed in the RFP 20-06; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has recommended ATL Diversified Inc. for selection; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to approve the rankings and select the recommended contractor to perform the sediment removal services; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the procurement and utilization of these services is in the best interest of the Village and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. **Approval of Ranking.** The Village Council of Islamorada, Village of Islands, hereby approves the Committee's final rankings and recommendations as follows:

1. ATL Diversified Inc.
2. Adventure Environmental Inc
3. Brance Diversified Inc.
4. Gator Dredging
5. Energy Resources, Inc.
6. LPS Contracting
7. Sea & Shoreline LLC
8. West Construction Inc.
9. Estate Management Services Inc.
10. American Dredging & Environmental

Section 3. Authorization of Village Officials. The Village Manager and/or his designee and the Village Attorney are authorized to negotiate a contract for the requested services with ATL Diversified, Inc, and enter into an agreement. Should contract negotiations fail at any time, the Village Manager may negotiate a contract with the firms recommended in the order listed in Section 2 of this Resolution and enter into an agreement.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
