

RESOLUTION NO. 21-09-85

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 21-07-63; ADOPTING A TENTATIVE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2021 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2022, PURSUANT TO SECTION 200.065, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Village Council of Islamorada, Village of Islands, Florida (the "Village"), determined a proposed millage rate for Fiscal Year 2021-2022, as set forth in Resolution No. 21-07-63 adopted on July 22, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Section 200.065(2)(c), Florida Statutes, require that a municipality re-compute the proposed millage rate and adopt a tentative millage rate within eighty (80) days of certification of taxable value; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council held a public hearing on September 3, 2021 to consider any adjustment of its proposed millage levy and to consider an operating budget for the Fiscal Year 2021-2022, beginning October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022 ("FY 21-22"), in accordance with the provisions of Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. **Adopting a Tentative Millage Rate.** The Village Council of Islamorada, Village of Islands, hereby resolves that the proposed millage rate on all taxable assessed property value for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 as set forth in Resolution No. 21-07-63 is hereby recomputed and

tentatively established at 3.0000 mills, which represents \$3.00 for each thousand dollars of taxable assessed property value (for the tax year commencing from and after January 1, 2021); and that the tentative millage rate of 3.0000 represents a 5.3% increase or .1510 mills above the rolled-back rate, which is 2.8490.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
