

RESOLUTION NO. 17-02-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA CONSIDERING A REDUCTION OF LIEN IN CODE COMPLIANCE CASE NO. CEWSTR20160000073; AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY AND EXPEDIENT ACTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Islamorada, Village of Islands (the “Village”) is a duly constituted municipality having such power and authority conferred upon it by the Florida Constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 162, Florida Statutes and the Village Code of Ordinances, the Village recorded a code compliance lien in Case No. CEWSTR20160000073 against property located within the Village at 174 Indian Mound Trail, Tavernier, Florida 33070; and

WHEREAS, as of October 13, 2016, the lien totaled Twenty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,750.00); and

WHEREAS, the Village’s Code Compliance Department has determined that the property is in compliance, and an Affidavit of Compliance has been issued for the property; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2-120 of the Village Code of Ordinances (the “Code”), on December 20, 2016, the Village Code Compliance Hearing Officer, after hearing testimony, entered an “Order Reducing Fines” thereby reducing the lien total of Twenty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,750.00) to Six Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Seven and 50/100 Dollars (\$6,437.50); and

WHEREAS, the property owner has requested a hearing for reconsideration before the Village Council seeking a further reduction of the lien amount; and

WHEREAS, Section 20-120(s) of the Code provides that the Village Council may, for good cause shown, reduce the fine below the fine reduction guidelines; and

WHEREAS, in determining good cause, the Village Council may consider the efforts of the owner to bring the property into compliance, the seriousness of the violation, prior violations, if any, the reduced lien amount approved by the Village Code Hearing Officer and any other relevant factors; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council finds that consideration of this Request for Reconsideration is in accordance with Chapter 162, Florida Statutes, and the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Consideration of Reduction. The Village Council hereby determines that there is good cause to reduce the fine below the fine reduction guidelines. Based on the foregoing, the Village Council recommends that the fine and lien amount be further **reduced by 40% to Three Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Two and 50/100 Dollars (\$3,862.50).**

Section 3. Authorization of Village Officials. The Village Manager is hereby authorized to take all necessary and expedient action to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
