Ordinance amending the Village code to modify the vessel exclusion zone/swim area generally located off Port Antigua and White Marlin Beach on Lower Matecumbe Key

Summary of Proposed Ordinance and Statement of Public Purpose to be Served

The proposed ordinance amends the vessel exclusion zone/swim area generally located waterward of the mean high-water line off of Port Antigua Beach & White Marlin Beach to expand the vessel exclusion zone/swim area by reducing the width of an area that was originally excluded from the vessel exclusion zone/swim area.
